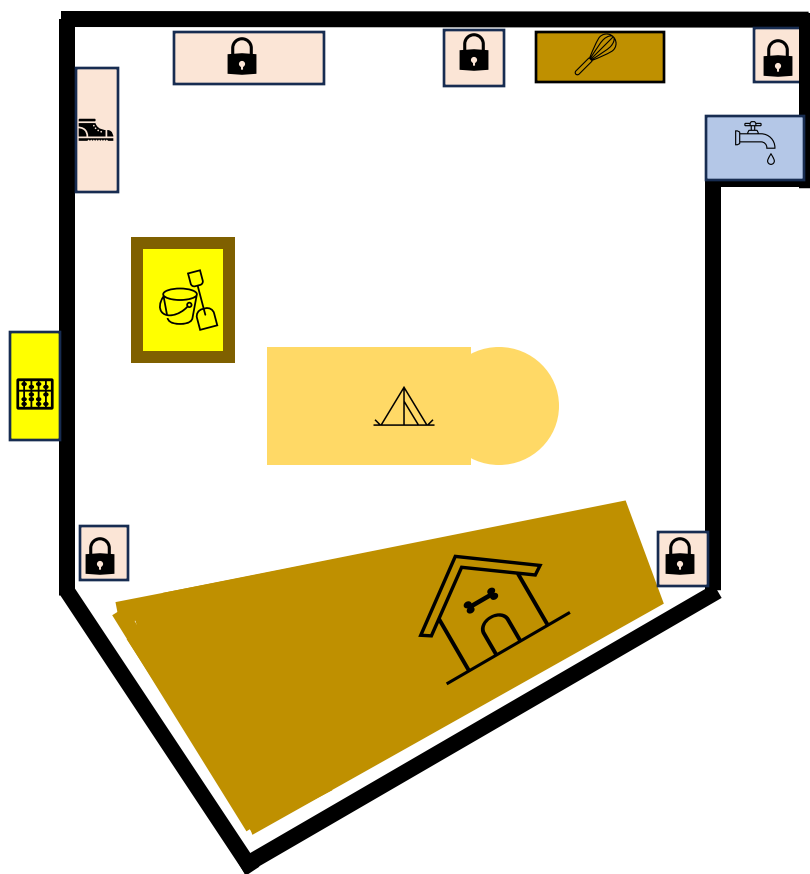

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# 1. Sensory Boards

Cost

£780 + VAT

Installation of three bright and stimulating multi-sensory wall art boards (one frame at 1.2m x 1.2m and two frames at 1.2m x 0.6m). Crafted using marine ply with a stained timber surround and a wide range of natural multi-sensory items, which are suitable for outdoors.





## 2. Storage Areas and Welly Wall

Creating a series of bespoke storage compartments which are purpose built for the space and storage compartments, to include:

- Four single storage cupboards, three at 1.2m x 1.2m x 0.6m and one at 0.8m x 1.2m x 0.6m
- One double storage cupboard at 2.4m X 1.2m X 0.6m
- Each unit will have three shelves.
- One welly storage area. 2.4m x 0.7m x 0.6m (to hold 60 pairs).

All storage areas will be made with a sturdy frame, shiplap cladding and include slide bolts which can have a padlock inserted if needed.

### 3. The Sand Pit

#### A 2m x 2m Sturdy Sandpit with Cover, Including:

- A solid, three-layered sandpit constructed from railway sleepers, finished with a robust 10x2 inch timber surround—ideal for seating and tinkering.
- An access step for easy entry and exit.
- A lightweight cover made from Shiplap cladding, complete with handles for easy lifting.
- Fully lined and filled with two tonnes of play-grade sand.
- Price includes removal of old sandpit

## 4. Den Building Area

**Construction of a den building area with shelving for toy storage, to include:**

- Installation of 5 upright rounded larch posts, each pre-drilled with holes to support den building.
- Creating a shelving area for accessible toy storage, 60cm wide x 60cm deep x 60cm high.
- Providing three unfixed tyres for storage of loose material
- Installation of larch posts to be co-ordinated to coincide with surfacing contractors.

## 5. The Storage Hut:

**Development of a 2.2 x 1.5 metre storage shelter, including:**

- Sleeper upright posts, securely cemented into the ground
- Three fully clad walls constructed using loglap cladding
- Timber tongue and groove roof for durability and weather resistance
- Open entrance doorway
- 90cm x 60cm whiteboard mounted on the back wall

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# Mud Station

A robust mud kitchen, measuring 2.4 meters in length and 1.2 meters at its tallest point. Features include:

- **Counter height customised** to suit the playground age group
- A **Belfast sink** with **taps**, **hobs**, a **chalk wall menu board**, an **oven**, a **cupboard**, and a **chopping board** for creative activities plus plenty of **shelving** and **hooks**.
- **Loglap backsplash**
- **A sleeper planter for storage of mud**, measuring 60cm width x 60cm depth x 40cm height

## 7. Waterfall Wall

**Creation of an interactive water play wall on the brick wall of the outhouse, including:**

- Installation of four decorative timber battens fixed to the wall using masonry screws
- A series of dynamic water channels constructed from a mix of materials, such as plastic guttering, bamboo shoots transparent water pipes and funnels
- A variety of attachments to allow children to control, redirect, and experiment with the flow of water
- A basin at the base of the wall to collect water from the runs
- A basin to collect water at the end of the water runs.
